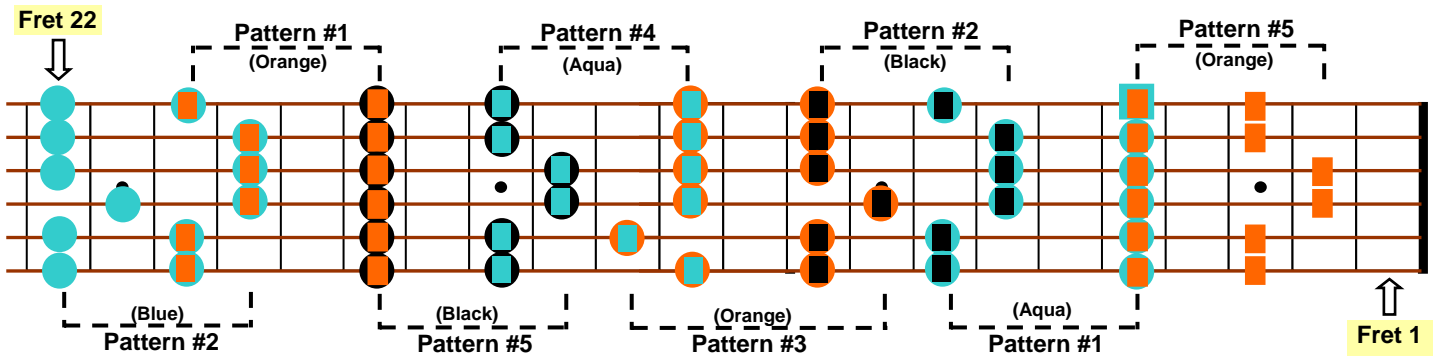


Lead Patterns / Scales – Minor Pentatonic

“The Fret board Puzzle”

It will be easier to understand Scales (often called Lead Patterns) if you can vision them fitting together on the fret board like a “Puzzle.” The patterns connect (as shown in the diagram) together all the way up and down the fret board, and some will repeat themselves.

All 5 Lead Patterns (Key of A) - How they fit together like a “puzzle” on the fret board.



(Notice how some patterns will be repeated again further down the fret board)

How to Practice the Lead Patterns: Start at the top of each pattern and pick each note slowly – pick the first note down, the second note up, and so on... Pick each note slowly, and try to get a good, clean sound from each note. **Remember to use “alternate” picking!**
