
Bass - Dorian Scales

(shown in all 5 positions)

The "Dorian" Scales use 7 notes (A, B, C, D, E, F#, G) – Two notes are added to the Minor Pentatonic scales to create the "Dorian" scale. You can hear the distinctive "Dorian" sound when playing these scales.

Dorian Scales - shown in the Key of "A"



* Use over minor, minor 7th, and minor 9th chords (Rock and Metal chord progressions).

Picking Sequence: It is suggested to "alternate" your picking (using the 1st and 2nd fingers of your picking hand) when practicing any of these scales - this will help develop coordination and speed between your right and left hands.
