
Bass – Mixolydian Scales

(shown in all 5 positions)

The "Mixolydian" scales are similar to the "Major" scales but with a lowered 7th note (A, B, C#, D, E, F#, G).

Mixolydian Scales – shown in the Key of "A"



* Use over Major, and Major 7th/ 9th/13th chords (Rock, Country / Southern Rock, and Jazz chord progressions).

Picking Sequence: It is suggested to "alternate" your picking (using the 1st and 2nd fingers of your picking hand) when practicing any of these scales - this will help develop coordination and speed between your right and left hands.
