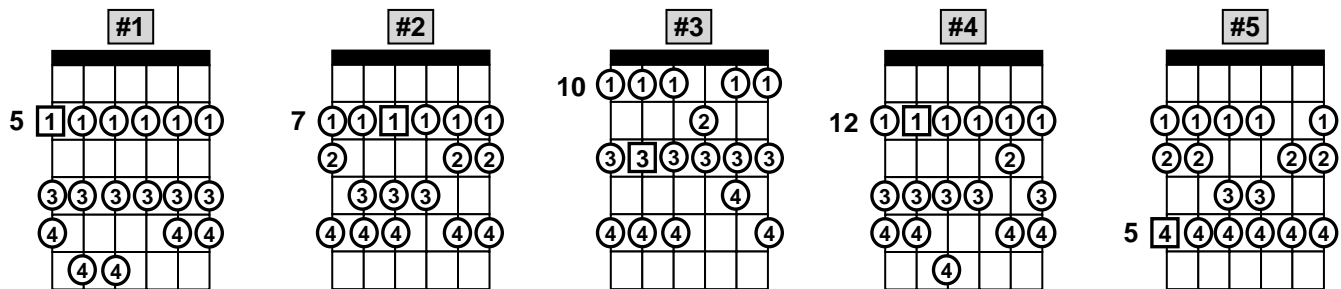


Dorian Scales – shown in all 5 positions...

The “Dorian” Scales use 7 notes (A, B, C, D, E, F#, G) – Two notes are added to the Minor Pentatonic scales to create the “Dorian” scale. You can hear the distinctive “Dorian” sound when playing these scales.

Dorian Scales



* Use with minor, minor 7th, and minor 9th chords (Rock and Metal chord progressions).

Picking Sequence:

It is suggested to “alternate” picking (using Down / Up picking) when practicing any of these scales (this will help develop coordination and speed between your right and left hands).
