
## **Intermediate Guitar Lessons**

## Intro chords to "Back in Black"

(only play the notes indicated)



As you can see in the chord diagrams above, not all the notes (strings) of the chords are being played? This is normal for Rock and Roll / Metal chord progressions – most of the time only 2, 3, or 4 notes of a chord are being played – these chords are called "Power Chords" (also called 5th's) – power chords are usually played with lots of distortion and at very loud levels. Keep this in mind when you are trying to figure out songs, start with the regular chord, then listen to the notes, and try to figure out if all the notes of the chord are being played? Or not? Power chords will be covered in a later lesson...

X = Do not play this string.

O = Open string.
