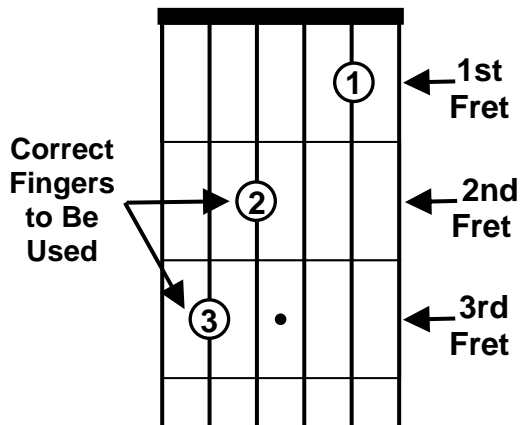


Beginner Lessons - The "C" Chord

This lesson will introduce you to another easy regular chord - the "C" chord. Both the "G" and "C" chords are usually the first chords that most guitar teachers show their students, mainly because they are fairly easy to learn and also both of these chords are very popular in songs that you will be learning.
Let's get started with the "C" chord...

The "C" Chord



= Indicates the furthest position on the frets that fingers can be placed – Note that your fingers don't have to be exactly in the middle of a fret.

The "fingering" of the "C" chord goes as follows. Place your 3rd finger on the 3rd fret of the 5th string. Place your 2nd finger on the 2nd fret of the 4th string, and place your 1st finger on the 1st fret of the 2nd string.
